“Kitchen Canary” Class at October 29th 2011 Show

We will have a special class for those wonderful birds, who may not be of known parentage, or in some other way, not eligible for entry in to the show. This will be a casual judging, based on the condition of the bird and how it presents itself in the cage. There will be few rules and regulations and this promises to be fun for all who participate.

Rules:

1. Any canary, any size, color, age or gender will be eligible.
2. Cage size will be less than 24” wide, tall or long. So any cage with no measurement greater than 24” will work.
3. The main criteria for judging the birds in this class will be **condition/health**
4. Second criteria will be how the bird shows or presents itself.
5. Cleanliness and suitability of the cage will be considered.
6. Seed and fresh water must be available in the cage
7. Entry fee is \$3.00 per bird

You do not have to be a member to either show a bird or sell at the Bird Mart.

Two male European Starlings have been brought to the Wildlife Rescue center. These are not wild in the United States. These are pet cage birds. They even talk! The birds will be available for adoption to someone who can care for them properly. They are not particularly hard to keep, but different from the kind of birds most of us are used to. They cannot stay at the Wildlife Rescue because they're not wild and can't be released into the wild. A little smaller than a crow, they have glossy feathers with iridescent purple, blue and green and are called the “poor man's Myna” for their mimicking of sounds. They eat insects and almost anything else...seed, weeds, fruit, etc. and they have their own cage. For more information call Janna at 209 862 3792.

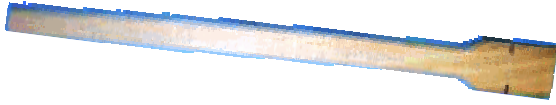

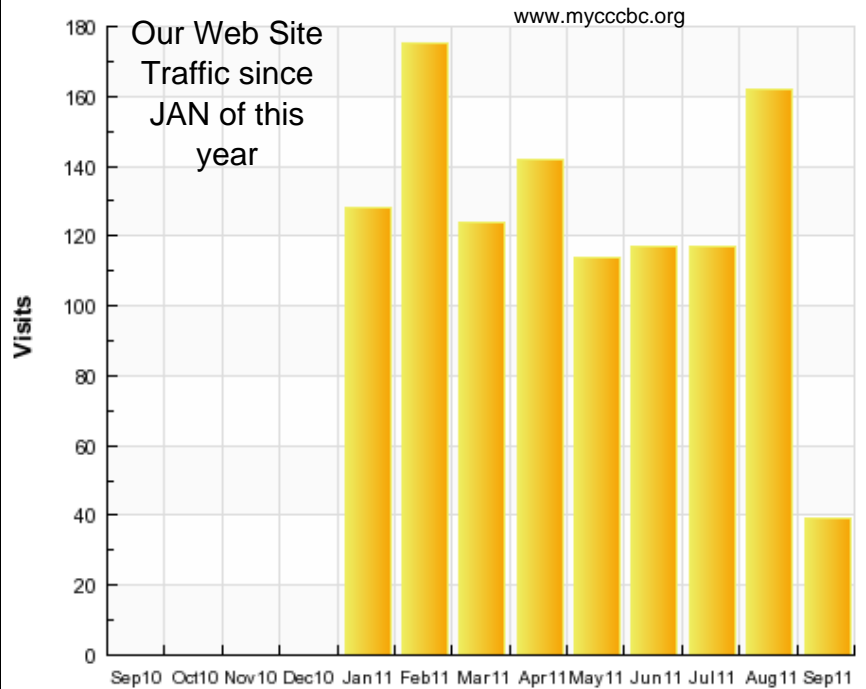
