

“Kitchen Canary” Class at October 30th 2010 Show

We will have a special class for those wonderful birds, who may not be of known parentage, or in some other way, not eligible for entry in to the show. This will be a casual judging, based on the condition of the bird and how it presents itself in the cage. Linda Hogan, our Type Canary judge will do the “honors” for this class. There will be few rules and regulations and this promises to be fun for all who participate.

Rules:

1. Any canary, any size, color, age or gender will be eligible.
2. Cage size will be less than 24” wide, tall or long. So any cage with no measurement greater than 24” will work.
3. The main criteria for judging the birds in this class will be **condition/health**
4. Second criteria will be how the bird shows or presents itself.
5. Cleanliness and suitability of the cage will be considered.
6. Seed and fresh water must be available in the cage
7. Entry fee is \$3.00
